For this project you will be choosing a province, drawing a map of it, and sharing information about it with the rest of the class. Here is what your project should include:

- 1) A map of the province that shows the capital city, other major cities and surrounding waters (lakes, rivers). Be sure your map has everything it needs, including a title, legend and directions.
- 2) The population of the province and the population of the capital city
- 3) Some information about the landform regions of the province, major industries, history of the province, how it got its name, when they joined confederation, the official bird, the official flower and the official flag (full page flag colored)
- 4) Please label a few interesting locations in your province (parks, recreation areas) that you think people should know about
- 5) A place you would like to visit and why
- 6) Be sure to use visual materials, like pictures or maps, that will help others learn about the province.
