**World Religion Website**

**Overview**

Throughout the course we have studied several different world religions. There are also many religions that we have mentioned briefly, but not studied in depth. This is your chance to examine another religion (other than your own) that you would like to know more about.

You will conduct research on your religious tradition, then present your information in the form of a website for the whole class to study.

**Requirements**

1. Your website needs to include the following:
  - a. A home page
  - b. Pages for (at least) **five** sub-topics from the following list:
    - i. Origins
    - ii. Beliefs
    - iii. Symbols
    - iv. Milestones
    - v. Practices/Rituals
    - vi. Festivals/Holidays
    - vii. Sacred Writings
  - c. A 'Works Cited' page (using MLA or APA)
  - d. A 'links page' (links to relevant websites)
  - e. A quiz: 10 questions that could be answered by your peers after reading through the site
2. Once all websites are finished, you will be expected to complete the quiz from three other websites
3. You will also need to submit your hand-written research notes, including the answer key for your quiz

**Suggestions**

- See the rubric for details on minimum number of sources and research note requirements
- Try to incorporate relevant images, maps and other visuals (and make sure to source them all). Find innovative and interesting elements about your topic that can enhance your website.
