

## A Christian Manifesto: Reading Reflection

### *Instructions:*

1. Read "A Christian Manifesto".
2. Remember the skills of a good reader
  - a. A good reader stops
  - b. A good reader asks questions
  - c. A good reader makes connections
3. Make at least 20 observations totaling 30 points or more
  - a. Something that is familiar to you
  - b. Something that is new to you
  - c. A question that comes to your mind—If your question about the meaning of a word, you must include the definition.
  - d. A connection
    - i. To you—something you've experienced in life
    - ii. To the text—something you remember reading elsewhere in the text
    - iii. To the world—i.e. a movie, TV show, song, book, game, etc.
4. Copy each item of observation onto your paper and include the page number
5. This assignment is worth 30 points and will be graded as follows:
  - a. Observations of familiarity are worth 1 point each
  - b. Observations of something new to you are worth 1 point each
  - c. Questions are worth 2 points each
  - d. Connections are worth 3 points each
6. Label your paper with your name in the upper left-hand corner
7. Title this assignment "A Christian Manifesto Reading Reflection"
