WATSON'S BIOWORLD Constitution

Welcome to Watson's Bioworld! As a new resident, you will have many outstanding opportunities for success. This document will allow you to be informed as to the many opportunities for you.

Government: The government of Watson's Bioworld is that of a constitutional monarchy with the Queen as the head of state.

- Queen - Ms. Susan Watson is a benevolent monarch and, as long as the laws of the land are obeyed, a generous one as well. Productive citizens are rewarded, but firm justice is applied to those who find it difficult to cooperatively reside in Bioworld.
- President - There is a President, rather than a Prime Minister. Since the financial system is that of capitalism, the President is determined by the amount of currency that he or she accrues. The President may often act on behalf of the Queen or at her direction. At any time, the President may be impeached if he or she loses currency, or if the President proves to be less than law-abiding. Accrual of currency is addressed later in this document. Term limits may be necessary and implemented as needed.
- Vice President and Secretary of Commerce/Finance – The Vice President is the person who holds the second greatest monetary value. Specific privileges and responsibilities are provided to the Vice President, including the disbursement of funds. Again, term limits may be imposed.
- Secretary of Justice, Security, and Defense – The Secretary will also act as Sheriff of Bioworld and will be responsible for enforcing laws, collecting fines and taxes, and bringing offenders to justice.
- Entrepreneurs – Any Bioworld resident has the opportunity to own property or to make money.

Financial System: Watson's Bioworld uses the Biobuck as its primary unit of currency. Biobucks may be earned by residents so as to provide for their Bioworld financial needs. However, taxes, fines, and other expenses will be due and payable from time to time; either to the government or to other residents.

Laws: The laws of Watson's Bioworld are those which have been established by the BCA Commonwealth of Nations, of which Bioworld is a part. Consequences for breaking certain laws are clearly outlined in the Commonwealth documents. Others are listed below.

Commerce: As a resident of Watson’s Bioworld, you have the opportunity to earn a comfortable salary with which to provide for your needs. The main unit of currency is the Biobuck. Biobucks may be earned by specific tasks or actions. They may also be lost in the same way. An income and expense table is provided as follows:

Entrepreneurial Opportunities: You may become a landlord or businessman by taking advantage of various opportunities. Some examples are given below. If you have independent ideas for making money, you may pursue them granted that they are first provided to the Queen for approval. You may seek an audience with the Queen to have her consider your proposal.

- Landlord – You may become a landlord by earning enough Biobucks so as to purchase property that can be rented to other residents. The following property may be purchased:

- Businessman – You may purchase items for resale. You can make a profit by selling them for more than you paid.

You may then rent or sell these items to other students. Please note the rental fees should be reasonable and in keeping with the current economy. Any excessive fees may be regulated by the government.

- Sporting and Games – From time to time, there will be sports or games in Bioworld where you may win Biobucks. The amounts will be determined at the time of the games.
- Tests and Quizzes – Biobucks may be used for extra credit points on tests and quizzes, up to ten points. Biobucks may only be used one time and will be voided or destroyed after use.

Please be advised that this Constitution may be changed without notice at the discretion of the Queen. Any changes will be disbursed to the citizenry by the President or his designated representative.
