

## Music Video Project Bible 7

Over fourth quarter, you will work with a group of two other students. As a three-student team, you will write, direct, and star in your own music video. This video will count for 25% of your entire Bible grade, so it is important to take this project seriously. (Just don't forget to have fun!)

Objective: Show your understanding of a Bible story or Biblical Truth (such as God's power) and through the music video prove the RELEVANCE of the story/truth in today's world.

### Requirements:

- Class time must be used wisely or your team will lose the privilege to work on your video altogether during class
- Video at least three minutes in length
- All members of your team included in the video
- Vocals must be clear, easy to understand
- Scripture reference spoken or shown

Late work WILL count against you. To avoid being penalized for a teammate's irresponsibility, you will also be required to follow the schedule below. This will also help you stay on track and receive credit when you deserve it.

### April 6, 2011

- Each team member will turn in their brainstorming session ideas.
- From your papers, it should be clear to me 1.) Which Bible story/truth you will be presenting in your video 2.) Generally how you will present that story, and 3.) What EACH team member will be in charge of throughout the process.

### April 27, 2011

- Each team member will turn in a typed section for what they are responsible.
- Combining your team's papers, you should have the following details:
- Music choice
- Lyrics
- At least two scene changes
- List of "characters" and their role
- Filming process
- Culture references/parallels (We will discuss this further in class)

### May 10, 2011

- Rough draft or "working clip" your team has created, up to this point.

### May 17, 2011

- MUSIC VIDEO PRESENTATION. No late videos will be accepted.
