As part of your study of the American Revolution, you will create an "Alphabet Book" which explains many of the complex terms, people, events, places, and concepts associated with this dramatic era of history. You are to use meaningful words and phrases from the materials used in class, as well as from your textbook, and from your research

Requirements: Due Date _____

For each letter of the alphabet you will need to make one entry. You may exclude 3 letters of your choice. Each of your entries must take up no more than 1 page. Your entries must contain the following and must be associated with the American Revolution.

- ✓ 6 causes of the war
- ✓ 4 significant people (2 males and 2 females)
- ✓ 6 key events
- ✓ 3 geographical locations
- ✓ The remaining 5 are entries of your choice

For each entry, identify the letter being used and write at least 2 sentences which provide an explanation or definition of the entry's significance to the American Revolution

For five of your entries, you must include an original visual (political cartoon, diagram, drawing, etc). For another of your five entries, you must include an already created visual. Make sure that your visuals depict how your entry reflects the American Revolution.

For two of your entries, you must include a primary source (one writing piece and one image). Include a caption under the primary sources identifying what it is.

Include a title page for your booklet that includes the name of the assignment, your name, and an image associated with the American Revolution.
