

Presidential Job Pie

Using the 8 Presidential jobs we have talked about, create a pie graph following the directions below. Check each one off as you complete it.

- ☐ Put the title of Presidential Job Pie on a separate paper
- ☐ Your job pie should represent how you personally think the President should divide his time for all his jobs. Determine how much of the pie should be spent on each job. Divide your pie into 8 sections according to your breakdown.
- ☐ Assign a color to each category of jobs and color in the appropriate pie section. Make a key explaining the color coding on your paper.
- ☐ Add a check to your pie pieces if you think Congress has some role in the President's job (example: As Commander in Chief, the President can send troops somewhere but Congress must declare war.)
- ☐ Put a star inside the five most important job sections. Add this symbol to your key.
- ☐ Put a □ inside the jobs you feel more American people should have more say in. Add this symbol to your key
- ☐ On the back or on a separate paper, write a one paragraph synopsis or summary of your presidential job pie telling why you ranked the jobs the way you did
