

# 97,300 DOORS BOUGHT

## One Item in Equipment Order for Parkchester Project

Another record building-material order has been placed by the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company in connection with its huge housing project known as "Parkchester" in the Bronx, it was learned yesterday.

The order calls for 97,300 panel doors and was placed with the Weisberg-Baer Company of Astoria, L. I., which is obtaining the Mississippi Delta sweet gum hardwood plywood required for 72,000 of the doors from the Mengel Company of Louisville, Ky.

The Mengel firm estimates that its order involves eighteen carloads of wood and that, if the entire 97,300 doors were placed end to end, they would stretch from New York to Atlantic City, a distance of 120 miles.

Other large orders recently received by the Weisberg-Baer Company include those for Queensbridge and Red Hook houses and Castle Village.
