

FREEDOMLAND LIENS FOR \$140,000 FILED

Three liens totaling more than \$140,000 were filed yesterday against Webb & Knapp, Inc., for work done in connection with Freedomland, the amusement park in the Bronx.

The largest of the liens was for an unpaid bill of \$122,763. It was filed by the Controlled Weather Corporation of 1157 Third Avenue for labor, air-conditioning and heating at Freedomland, which is owned by Webb & Knapp, Inc.

Another lien was for \$15,358 for steel provided by the Capitol Steel Corporation of 1150 Avenue of the Americas for construction of the Freedomland Inn Motel at 2530 Baychester Avenue, adjoining the amusement park. The third lien, for \$2,501, also was filed by the Capitol Corporation for steel for a restaurant in the motel.

All the liens were filed at the office of the Bronx County Clerk.

Commenting on the charges, a spokesman for Webb & Knapp said:

"The two liens by the Capitol Steel Corporation will be paid. The \$122,763 involved in the Controlled Weather Corporation lien is in dispute, Webb & Knapp not being satisfied with respect to completion of the contract."

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
