

# **MORE FAMILIES TO MOVE**

## **144 Must Make Way for Women in the Armed Services**

Another 144 families living in the vicinity of the recently established training center for women at Hunter College in the Bronx will have to move to new homes to make way for the expanding women's Navy groups. This was announced yesterday after Federal Judge Alfred C. Coxe had signed an order condemning apartment buildings at 2745 Reservoir Avenue, and 2824 and 2845 University Avenue, for use by the Navy.

No date for the removal of present occupants was disclosed yesterday, that announcement being left to Washington officials. In a statement from the Third Naval District here, however, it was said that free moving facilities were expected to be provided. This service was supplied for many of the 613 families previously cleared from thirteen other buildings. With the new housing facilities, the Hunter center will have accommodations for 5,250 staff members and students, and 500 transient Waves, Spars and Marines.
