

# RENT REBATES DECLARED

---

## Tenants in Cooperative Houses Receive Almost \$30,000

---

Rent rebates amounting to almost \$30,000 have been declared by the Amalgamated Housing Corporation in the Bronx and Amalgamated Dwellings, Inc., on Grand Street, in Manhattan. The rebates have just been announced by A. E. Kazan, manager of both projects.

The rebate amounted to \$21,175 on the Bronx development, which was established seventeen years ago and consists of 685 families whose average rental is \$10.85 per month per room. The Manhattan development rebated \$8,604. It consists of 235 families who pay an average of \$12.22 per month per room.
