

# 3 BANKS TO SERVE AREA

## Branches Being Set Up Around Parkchester Development

The Metropolitan Life Insurance Company's \$50,000,000 Bronx housing development, Parkchester, will be served by three banks, the Bronx Board of Trade announced yesterday. The Bronx County Trust Company has already opened a branch at Hugh J. Grant Circle and the National City Bank now has under construction a branch office at 1498 Metropolitan Avenue, near Metropolitan Oval. It is expected that this branch will open on Nov. 1.

The Dollar Savings Bank of the City of New York has purchased a plot on 177th Street and Hugh J. Grant Circle. The bank will build a modern branch office on the site, which is directly opposite the main entrance to Parkchester.
