

WAVES AT HUNTER GET NEW RECREATION HALL

Morris Attends Presentation by B'nai B'rith Service Council

Council President Newbold Morris was the principal speaker at the presentation in behalf of the B'nai B'rith War Service Council to the Waves at the Naval Training School at Hunter College in the Bronx of a completely furnished and equipped recreation center at special dedication ceremonies yesterday afternoon. Capt. William S. Amsden, commanding officer of the school, accepted the presentation.

The recreation center, occupying the West Lounge, is furnished with sofas, easy chairs, tables, lamps, a writing desk, mirror, pictures, three card tables, two ping-pong tables and a radio, supplied by B'nai B'rith. The organization also furnished the adjoining sun deck. The center will be maintained by the Riverdale Lodge of B'nai B'rith.

The invocation was by Chaplain Newell D. Lindner, the benediction by Chaplain Francis McVeigh. Abraham Mopper, vice president and chairman of the War Service Council of B'nai B'rith, made the official presentation.
