

WAVES TO HOLD REVIEW

3,000 Will Drill at 'USS Hunter' Saturday in Recruit Drive

Preceding the third anniversary of the Waves, Monday, a review and drill by 3,000 members will be held Saturday at the "U. S. S. Hunter," the Waves training school at the Bronx division of Hunter College, it was announced yesterday.

Of the 86,000 Waves more than 8,000 are now on duty and in training in the local Third Naval District. About 3,000 are training at the "U. S. S. Hunter." Some 5,000 others in the district are at jobs ranging from instructing in aerial navigation to caring for sick and wounded sailors and marines.

In observance of the third anniversary the Office of Naval Officer Procurement has been enlisting a special "Fighting Lady Task Force" of new Waves throughout the district. To spur this campaign the "U. S. S. Hunter" will hold open house today and tomorrow from 2 P. M.
