

BRONX STUDIO IS SOLD.

Decatur Avenue Building to Be Used to Produce Movies.

The four-story Edison studio building at 2,826 Decatur Avenue, containing twenty dressing rooms, six mob rooms, projection room, executive offices and other facilities for the production of motion pictures, has been purchased by Edwin Earle Smith, independent producer, according to an announcement yesterday by Mr. Smith.

The property was sold by R. L. Griffin. The new owner said he bought the studio to produce thirteen talking features and fifty-two short pictures within the year. Mr. Smith is president of the Famous Sound Studio Corporation. The building contains a large stage 85 by 120 by 32 feet. Mr. Smith said production will begin in about six weeks.
