

CHRYSLER BUILDING OPENS

Many Visitors Inspect New Grand Central Zone Skyscraper.

Hundreds of visitors inspected the Chrysler Building, latest addition to the Grand Central zone's office skyscrapers, at the informal opening of the structure yesterday. Elevators were kept busy during the day carrying passengers as far as the sixty-seventh floor of the seventy-seven-story structure. Among those who went through the building were several students from Lehigh University's electrical engineering classes.

Formal opening of the entire building and the observation floor will be held later. Some tenants already moved into their new offices. Among those taking large space is the Texas Company, which is occupying the space from the sixteenth to the twenty-ninth floor.
