

# DELEGATES REVIEW WAVES

## Group From United Nations See 3,000 Parade at Hunter

Members of thirteen national delegations to the United Nations Conference were guests of honor at a reception yesterday at the U. S. S. Hunter, Women's Naval Reserve Training School, the Bronx. Thirty delegates from Belgium, China, Egypt, France, Greece, Iran, Lebanon, the Netherlands, Saudi Arabia, Syria, Turkey and Yugoslavia were welcomed by Capt. William F. Amsden, USN, commanding officer, and Dean Virginia Gildersleeve of Barnard College, a member of the United States delegation to the conference.

After witnessing a regimental review of the 3,000 Waves now in training at the school, the delegates made a tour of inspection of the station. Dean Gildersleeve explained that the reception and review had been arranged to acquaint foreign officials with the training of the Waves.
