

FIRE AT FREEDOMLAND

Six Unfinished Buildings Are Destroyed in Park in Bronx

A three-alarm fire last night destroyed six small, unfinished buildings at Freedomland, a 205-acre amusement park under construction in the Baychester section of the Bronx. No one was injured.

A half-mile-long relay of hose lines was used to get water to the flames from a hydrant at Baychester and Bartow Avenues.

The cause of the fire was not determined and there was no estimate of damage. A spokesman for the park said the fire would not affect the scheduled opening date of June 19.
