

Marble Hill Mobilizes Against Bronx Anschluss

Fearful lest Borough President James J. Lyons of the Bronx actually carry out his threat to annex Marble Hill as part of the Borough of Universities, the residents of the unhappy "Sudetenland" on the Harlem Ship Canal have formed the Marble Hill Association to stave off legal an-schluss.

"The residents of this garden spot have formed the Marble Hill Civic Association to fight this attempted steal," V. J. Anderson, president of the organization, declared yesterday. "Governor Lehman is now in possession of a petition of 1,000 names requesting that our rights be respected and suggesting that if anything is to be done in the way of annexation, that Manhattan take over the Bronx.

"We are requesting, in addition to the Governor, the backing of Mayor La Guardia, Newbold Morris, Thomas E. Dewey and Christopher Sullivan."
