

MORE FOR PARKCHESTER

100 Families Added in Day to Tenant List in Bronx

More than 100 families, among the first of the 12,200 families who eventually will occupy Parkchester, the \$50,000,000 Metropolitan Life Insurance Company housing development on the site of the old Catholic Protectory in the East Bronx, moved yesterday into the four completed units of the apartment community. The first tenants moved in last week.

Moving vans, taxicabs and automobiles arrived in a steady stream and the lobbies of the four units were jammed with the furniture and other belongings of the tenants. The completed buildings are in the south quadrant, one of Parkchester's four main sections. On one side they face the park recreational center around which the quadrant is centered and on the other McGraw Avenue and Unionport Road.
