

## **3,000 Waves Hail War's End**

Three thousand Waves in training at Hunter College in the Bronx released their emotions at the end of the war by throwing their hats in the air, flinging cut-up paper from dormitory windows and adding their voices to the general uproar. An official at the training center said, however, that peace would bring no change in the regular schedule of studies and that Waves would receive no extension of time on their passes.
