

BRONX DETOURS SLATED

**Made Necessary by Work on
Elevated Expressway**

The Police Department announced plans yesterday to re-channel traffic when work starts next week on the elevated expressway over Bruckner Boulevard in the Bronx.

Traffic will be re-directed in the area between 140th Street and Longwood Avenue. Signs have been posted notifying the motorists of the planned work.

The northbound center and service roadways will be closed at 140th Street and traffic directed to the southbound center roadway.

Southbound passenger vehicular traffic will be diverted to the southbound service road at Longwood Avenue while commercial traffic will be shunted one block west at that point to Southern Boulevard and then south again.
