# LIEN ON FREEDOMLAND

## \$3,648,000 Claim Is Filed by Turner Construction

---

A mechanic's lien for \$3,648,000 was filed yesterday by the Turner Construction Company against Freedomland, the amusement park in the Bronx.

It is the remainder due on a general contract for a large part of the construction work on the park. The work was done jointly by Turner and the Aberthaw Construction Company.

Payment of \$10,000,000 has been made to date on the contract, according to F. W. Warren, executive vice president of Turner. He said the lien was filed to establish a legal position required by law. The law requires the filing within a specified time after the date the last construction is performed.
