

NEW PARISH GETS SITE

Church of St. Helena to Build on Westchester Avenue Corner

The Roman Catholic Archdiocese of New York has bought as the site for a church and school for the new parish of St. Helena the property at the northwest corner of Westchester and Olmstead Avenues, running through to Benedict Avenue, Bronx.

The property is 200 by 275 by 240 feet and was purchased from the Elmcroft Corporation and Charles Ambrose through John J. Reynolds, broker. It was sold for cash and adjoins Parkchester, the housing development of the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company.
