

State to Speed Building Of 2 Highways in Bronx

ALBANY, Aug. 23—Plans to speed the construction of two major expressways in the Bronx were announced today by the State Public Works Department.

Superintendent J. Burch McMorran reported that the segment of the Bruckner Expressway west of the Triborough Bridge would be completed late in 1962 instead of by February, 1963.

The department has been subjected to some criticism because the middle part of this elevated section, completed but ending abruptly in midair at Lafayette Avenue, is unusable until the rest of the Bruckner Expressway is finished.

Mr. McMorran also reported that bids would be let, in October for a one-mile section of the Arthur V. Sheridan Expressway. It will run north from the intersection of the Bruckner Expressway and Lowell Street to just north of the Cross Bronx Expressway.
