

## **UNION'S HOMES APPROVED.**

**State Housing Board Backs Bronx  
Apartments of Clothing Workers.**

The State Board of Housing, of which Darwin R. James is Chairman, announced yesterday its approval of the Amalgamated Housing Corporation, a limited dividend corporation, which is erecting six apartment houses in Sedgwick Avenue in the Bronx.

The six units will afford housing relief for 303 families at \$11 a room a month when they are completed next February.

The total cost of the operation will be \$1,825,000, of which \$1,200,000 has been lent by the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company. The balance represents the investment of the co-operators, for the most part members of the Amalgamated Clothing Workers of America, a trade union of workers in the men's clothing industry.
