

Waves May Occupy Hunter's Bronx Unit

Uptown Hunter College, at Bedford Park Boulevard and Navy Avenue, the Bronx, is to be utilized by the Navy for the training of Waves, it was reported yesterday afternoon. This would be the first institution of higher education in the city to be used for the training of women naval reserves.

An announcement of the plan is expected soon.

Uptown Hunter is a division of the municipally owned colleges and could accommodate several hundred trainees. It is one of the two coal-burning colleges operated by the city, the other being uptown City College. Dr. George N. Shuster is president of Hunter and has his office at the main building, Sixty - eighth Street and Park Avenue.

It was reported that officials of another local college had offered the use of their women's dormitories for the training of a corps of Waves. The headquarters for the Waves are at Smith College, Northampton, Mass.
