Go to URL earth.google.com



Click "download Google Earth 6"

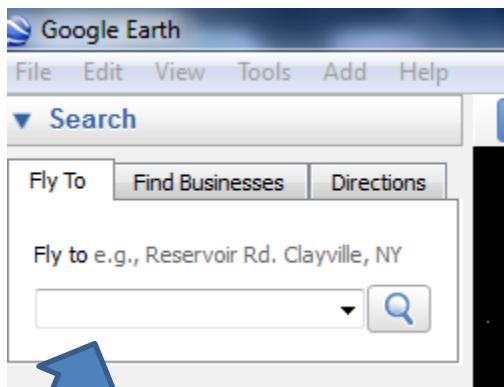


Once download is complete, Locate this icon



on your desktop. Double click

Features within Google Earth:

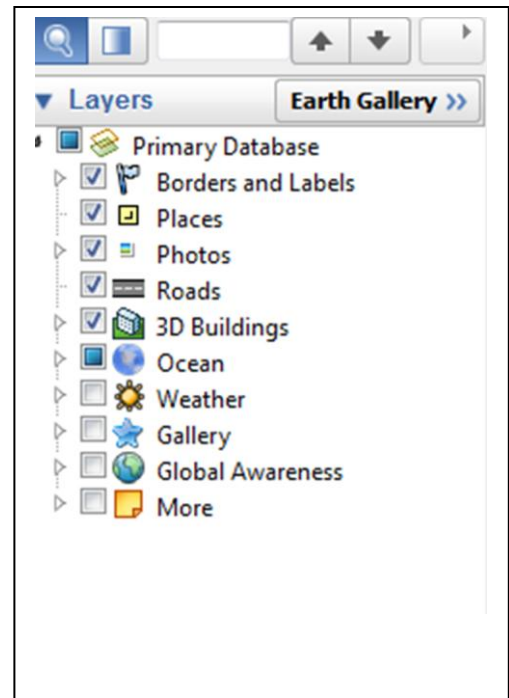


Locate the search box on the top left of the Google Earth screen. Type a location into the search box, then click the magnifying glass to find that place in the world.

Locate the directional buttons on the right of the screen. By clicking on the arrows, you can move left, right, up or down. By clicking on the + or -, you can zoom in or out on an area.



Locate the Layers area on the bottom right of the Google Earth Screen. By placing a check in the box next to one of the layer items, you can see that item on your map.



Locate this area on the top of your Google Earth screen.

For this training, we will focus on these five:



This button allows you to pinpoint a location.



This button will allow you to create a path from one pinpointed location to another.



This ruler button will allow you to measure the mapped path.



Use this button to show time lapse over a selected location.



Clicking this button will allow you to visit Mars, the Moon or the Sky. We will discuss this more later.
