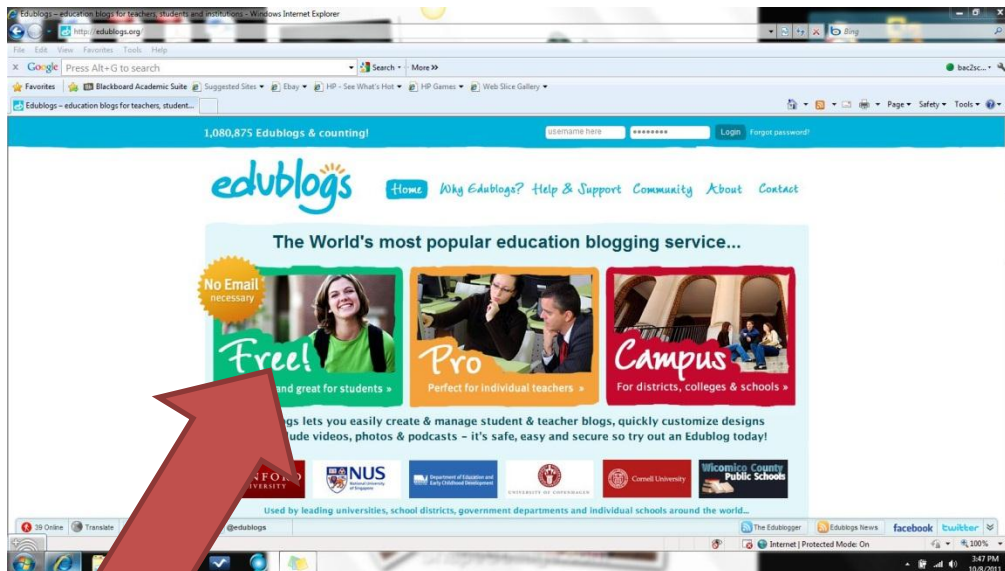


## Edublogs Video Tutorial Handout

Open Internet Explorer and type [www.edublogs.org](http://www.edublogs.org) in the URL address box.



-Choose a language that fits the intended audience by clicking the arrow (dropdown box) on the line that states English.

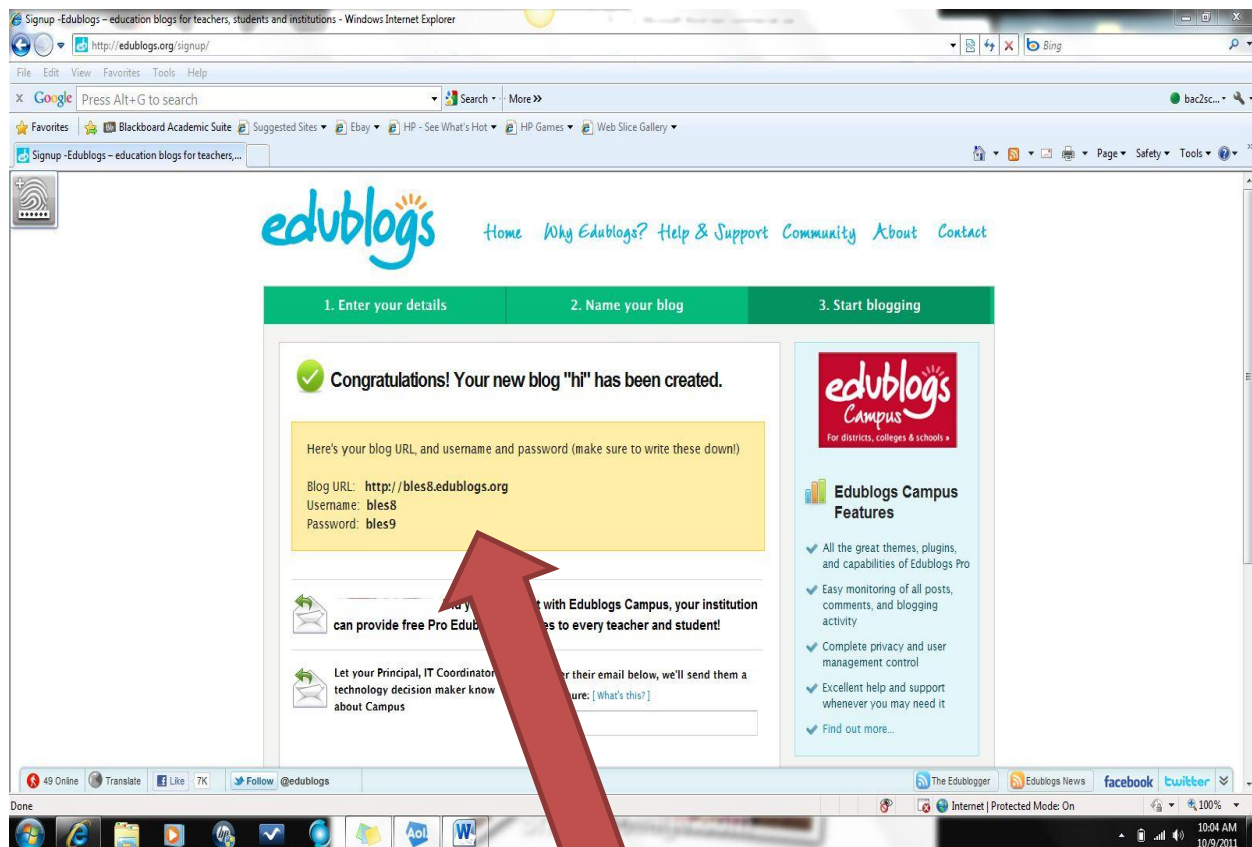
-Choose a blog type. When you click the arrow you will see student, teacher and other. Choose the type.
