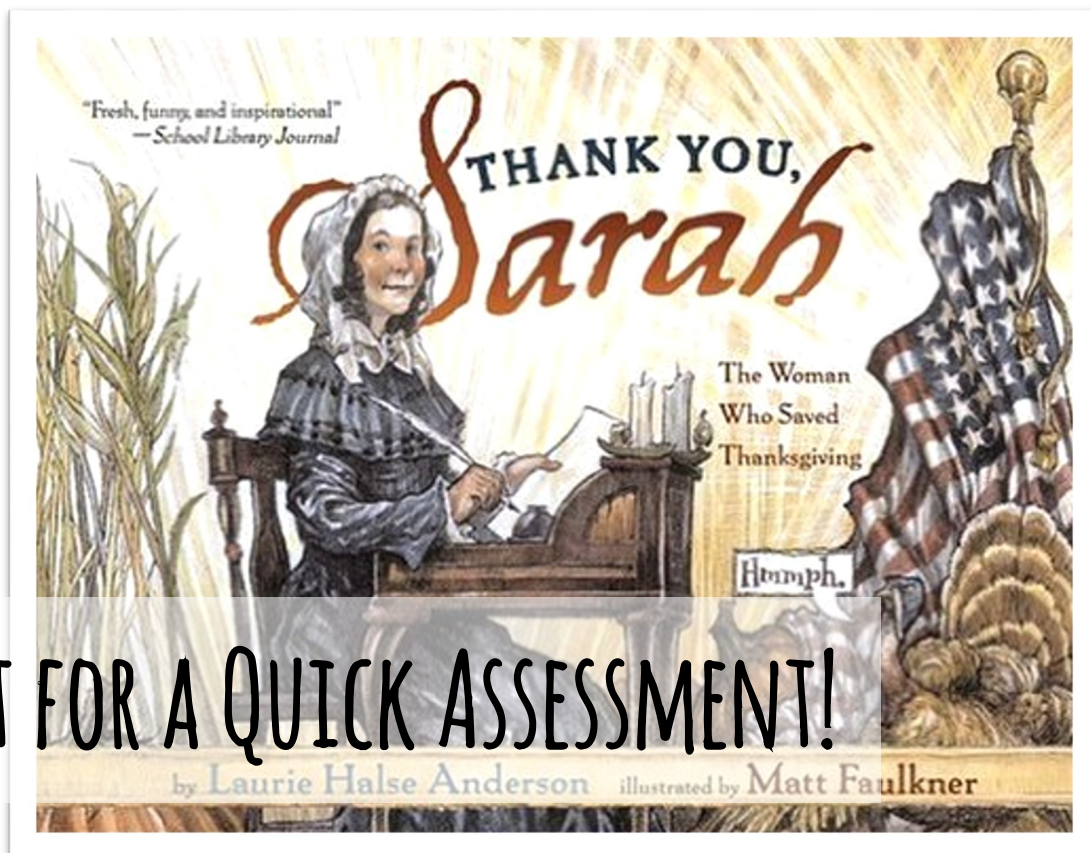

or

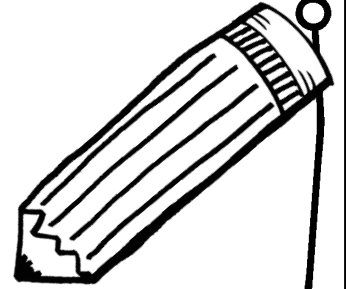
