



GIRAFFE CRAFT

There's more to this weaving project than meets the eye! To make a rectangular weaving, fold a 9" x 12" sheet of colorful construction paper in half (to 9" x 6"). Starting at the fold, cut a series of one-inch strips, stopping approximately one inch from the open ends. Unfold the resulting loom and weave six 1½" x 9" colorful construction paper strips in the loom. Glue the ends of each woven strip in place. Assemble the projects into a giraffe shape like the one shown. Invite students to study the colorful critter and submit proposals for other critters to be woven. Then let the weaving continue!
