Kansas A-M

1. Amelia Earhart – grew up in Atchison.
2. Walter P. Chrysler – Boyhood home in Wamego and Ellis. Created the Chrysler car brand.
3. Wheat – we produce more wheat than any state in the US.
4. Robert Ballard – First person to discover where the Titanic reached its final resting place.
5. Charles Curtis – Native American vice president
6. Dodge City – gun smoke, wild west
7. Eisenhower – We like Ike! Planned D-Day, later became president. Loved to golf.
8. Fly-Swatter – invented by a group of boy scouts to prevent the spread of disease.
9. Bill Farmer – had the voice of goofy.
