

jù xíng jiè shào 句型介绍

jù xíng gōu tōng
句型沟通：Sentence for communication

Greeting others: Name/title + greeting!

To greet others, first we address the person, and then add the greeting.

Name/title + greeting! For example:

Person A: ^{nǚ hái} 女孩, ^{nǐ hǎo} 你好! Hello, girl!

Person B: ^{nán hái} 男孩, ^{nǐ hǎo} 你好! Hello, boy!

Person: ^{lǎo nǚ nǚ} 老奶奶, ^{zài jiàn} 再见! Good-bye, old granny!

Person B: ^{nán hái} 男孩, ^{zài jiàn} 再见! Good-bye, old grandpa!

For people that you are familiar with, you can simply say Name/title+好. For example:

Students: ^{lǎo shī hǎo} 老师好! Hello, teacher!

Teacher: ^{tóng xué mén hǎo} 同学们好! Hello, students!

The difference between ^{nín} 您 and ^{nǐ} 你:

Both ^{nǐ} 你 and ^{nín} 您 are pronouns of “you”. The former is generally used with colleagues of one’s age, younger people, close friends or acquaintances. The latter is applied to elders or higher-ranking officers as a respectful form of addressing.
