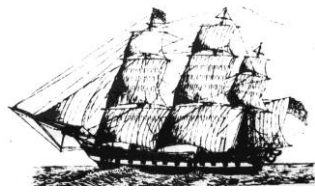


SA Colonial History Assignment

Geography

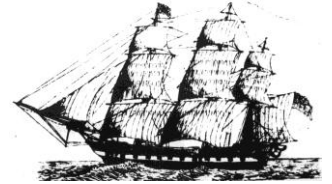
On a blank map of the world locate the country that your chosen culture migrated from.

On a second **inset** map of your country locate and show the following:

- The States and Territories (showing boundaries)
- List 5 places of significance.
- Highlight the bodies of water and surrounding oceans.
- Find a brief description of the climate (remember climate is a long term view of weather patterns)

E.g.

The climate of South Australia varies, from hot and dry in the interior to the milder, wetter climates of the southern Mount Lofty Ranges and the southeast coast of South Australia. Median annual rainfall ranges from about 100 mm in the area east of Lake Eyre to more than 1000 mm on the higher parts of the Mount Lofty Ranges.



Locate a traditional recipe of this culture, print in colour and answer the following questions:

- Were the ingredients for this dish available in SA in 1836-1900?
- Would it have been possible to make this recipe? Why or why not? (Explain your answer)

Find a picture of the traditional dress/clothes of this culture during the 1800s.

You may choose to make paper dolls to show the clothes or create clothes to go onto small dolls or peg people.

Find an example of the language of this culture.

Example: a piece of writing or copy of a letter that shows the written form of this language.

Hint: the web is great place to search for this or go to the library and look for books about this culture.

- Is this language similar or different to the English language?
- How well would they have been able to communicate with other members of the colony?
- What difficulties do you think they would have faced?

What were the **traditional skills (jobs) of the people of this culture**? Were they farmers,?

- Would it have been easy or difficult for them to find work?
- Why or why not? (Explain your answer)
