

# ***Class Prayer Project***

In partners, each student will be rostered to run the class prayer for three mornings and each day will be different. The time for prayer = 5 to 7 minutes and is an admin activity (8.45 a.m. to 9.00 a.m.)

***Your week's prayer activities will include 3 of the following: (You choose)***

1. Power Point or Movie Maker (or similar)
2. You Tube or music clip
3. Guided Reflection
4. Shared Prayer Card

## **Power Point or Movie Maker** (or similar)

- Minimum of 12 slides of images reflecting your theme (Clip Art, Google Images)
- At least 5 seconds transitions
- Min 2 minutes and max of 5 minutes
- Music = instrumental (no singing) to create a mood that reflects your theme

## **You Tube or Music Clip**

Locate a You Tube or video clip that reflects the theme you have chosen.

The You Tube should be of a Christian nature. Ask for help if you're not sure.

## **Guided Reflection**

- Go to [www.prayingeachday.org/reflect.html](http://www.prayingeachday.org/reflect.html)
- Select the month you are rostered on.
- Select the dates for the week you are rostered on.
- Print or save each of the prayers for your rostered week.
- Carefully read each one and select the one you like best.
- Write some notes about why you chose this prayer.
- Does it fit your theme for the week?
- Analyze the prayer: What do you think it means?

## Shared Prayer Card

Create a prayer card to share with the class. The cards will need to be double-sided A5, publisher is a good program for helping create this layout.

Include the following:

1. Title- your theme
2. Pictures to support your theme
3. Description of your chosen virtue
4. A prayer reflecting your theme
