1920-1933 Prohibition:
Prohibition shaped America in the 1920s.

Oct. 10, 1919 Volstead Act:
The Volstead Act outlined prohibition. Prohibition had a major impact on the 1920s, as people went to extreme lengths to get their alcohol.

1920 KKK rebirth:
During the 1920s, the KKK experienced a growth in power and people.

1920 19th Amendment Passed:
Women got the right to vote.

July 10, 1925 Scopes Trial Begins:
