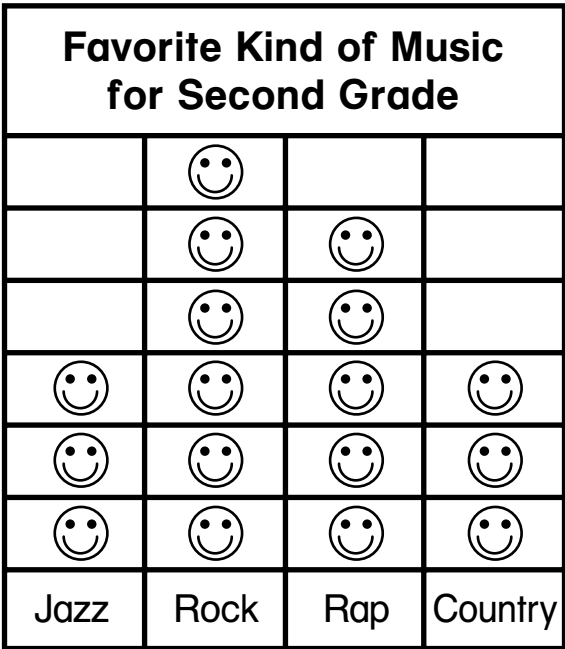
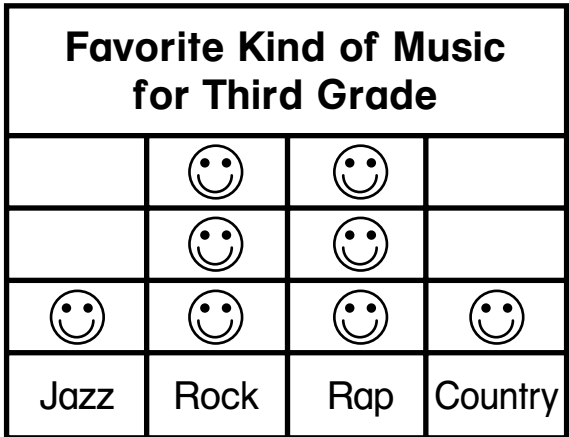


Face the Music
