- Information assurance/network security/cyber security



Sabre STEM Scholarship

Program Description

Sabre STEM Scholarship Program

The Sabre Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) Scholarship is designed to support graduating high school seniors planning to further their education in one of the STEM disciplines. Through the STEM scholarship program, Sabre is doing its part to help build a competitive workforce of scientists, technologists, engineers and mathematicians in order to sustain our growing global economy and to meet the increasing demands of the 21st century.

Sabre will award one (1) \$1,000 non-renewable scholarships to a high school senior that meets the eligibility criteria as described below.

Eligibility/Requirements

To be eligible, a candidate must:

- Be a United States Citizen
- Have a minimum 3.25 cumulative GPA based on grading scale of 4.0
- Be a high school senior graduating from one of the following high schools:
 - Archbishop Wood, Central Bucks East, Central Bucks South, Central Bucks West, North Penn, or William Tennant
- Be enrolled in an accredited, U.S. college or university, full-time for the upcoming fall semester
- Plan to pursue an undergraduate degree in science, technology, engineering or math within the following disciplines:
 - Engineering: Aerospace, Civil, Computer, Electrical, Mechanical
 - Information Sciences & Technology
 - Statistics
 - Mathematics
 - Geographic Information Systems
 - Teaching in STEM areas
 - Information assurance/network security/cyber security
- Complete and submit a Sabre STEM Scholarship Application Package during the application acceptance window listed on the application
- Not be a Sabre Systems, Inc. employee or a direct relative of a Sabre Systems, Inc. employee. Direct relatives are defined as spouses, parents, grandparents, uncles, aunts, children, siblings, nieces, or nephews, whether by blood, adoption, or marriage

Selection Criteria

Scholarships will be awarded using the following criteria:

- Academic records
- Personal Statement
- STEM Activities/Experience
- Letter of Recommendation

Award

The award winner will be presented with a certificate by a local Sabre representative prior to the end of the school year. The local committee member for each region will contact the award winner(s) to determine how and when the certificate will be presented. The award check will be sent directly to the college or university once the student is enrolled.
