



Using Overdrive with your Kobo

1. Go to www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions/ and follow the onscreen instructions for downloading and installing Adobe Digital Editions.
2. Open Adobe Digital Editions. Create an Adobe account and authorize your computer as one of your six devices. You must create an account to transfer Overdrive eBooks to your Kobo!
3. With Adobe Digital Editions open, attach your Kobo to the computer via the USB port. You will be prompted to authorize your eBook reader. Follow the instructions to authorize the Kobo!

Finding & Downloading eBooks

1. Go to www.olsn.ca/whitestonelibrary. Click the box that says "Download audiobooks – eBooks".
2. Click "Login" in the top menu. Type "Whitestone-Hagerman Memorial Public Library". In the box below, type your library card number.
3. Once you are logged in, use the navigation panel on the left to search for the eBook or audiobook you would like. When you have found the title you want, click the book cover.

Note: all copies of a book are out, you may place a hold. Overdrive will email you when the items you have on hold are in!

4. You may now take out the title using the "Borrow" button beside the item. The item will automatically be added to your "Bookshelf". Click "Bookshelf" to download the title, read in your browser, or see all of the items you have out.

Note: You can change the length of time you take books out for by going into your "Settings", underneath "Bookshelf".

5. Select the appropriate format – with a Kobo, this will often be ePub or PDF. You will receive a warning that you can only pick *one* format. Click "confirm". You will then have the option to "Download" your eBook.
6. When asked "Do you want to open or save this file, select "open". The title will automatically open in Adobe Digital Editions. If it does not automatically open, locate the downloaded file, which ends in .acsm, double click it and it will open in Adobe Digital Editions.
7. Using Adobe Digital Editions with your Kobo plugged in, click "Library View". Find the title(s) you downloaded in your library and drag & drop it onto the Kobo icon below the bookshelves. You will see the file copy to the Reader.
8. Detach your Kobo and enjoy your book!
