

## PhotoBucket Tutorial #26

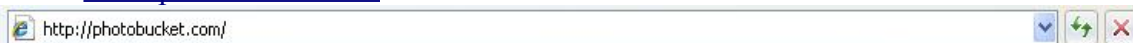
Photobucket is an image hosting service on the Internet. The website allows you to store your own images in albums, gives you codings for each image (that you can use in blogs, emails and websites), allows you to upload images from different locations (cellphones, URL, email and computer) and allows you to edit your images.



There are many photo editing websites on the Internet such as [www.picknik.com](http://www.picknik.com), [www.fotoflexer.com](http://www.fotoflexer.com), [www.wowapic.com](http://www.wowapic.com). Many of these websites follow almost similar instructions. For this demonstration we will be using Photobucket.

### Uploading Photos

- (1) Go to [www.photobucket.com](http://www.photobucket.com)



- (2) Sign in to your account (or create an account)

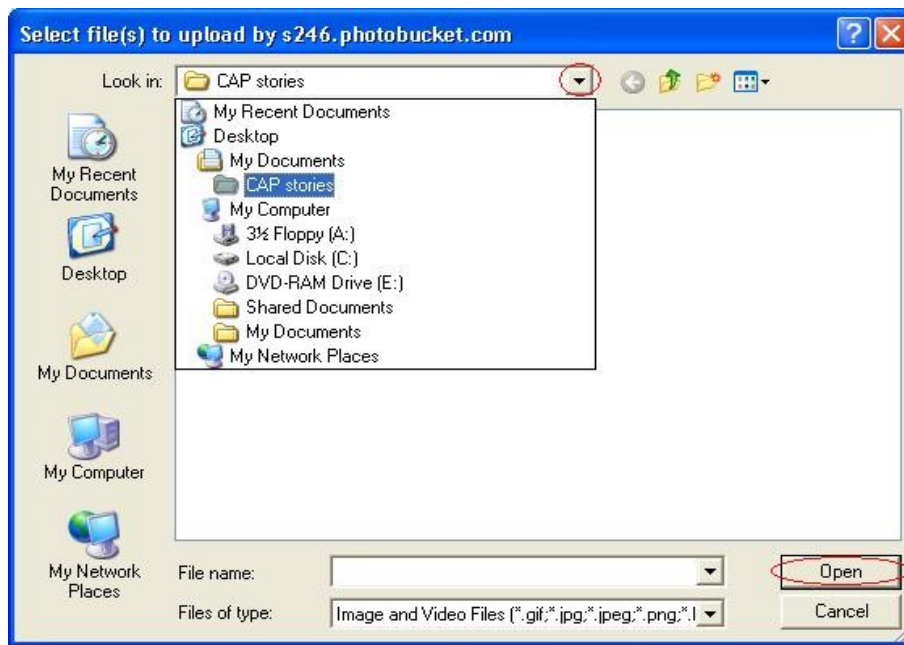

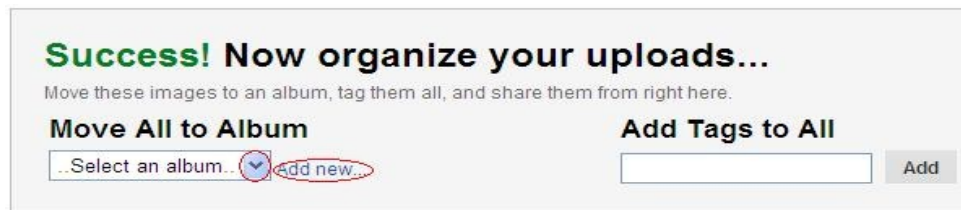
- (3) Left click on “upload images & video”



- (4) From “Select files to upload...” choose your photo. Left click once on the image location and left click on “Open”



- (5) File will begin to upload. (This may take a while depending on your connection)
- (6) Left click on the drop box menu under “Move All to Album” and select option or left click on “Add new...” to create a new album



- (7) To save these changes, scroll down the page and left click on “Save & Return to album”



## Putting Photos in a Blog

If you blog and you want to add photos, follow the directions below. For this demonstration, we will be using [www.livejournal.com](http://www.livejournal.com).

- (1) Decide which photo you want to use for the blog
- (2) In photobucket, use your mouse to scroll on top of the image (Don't click!). A menu will appear below the image. Under “HTML Code,” left click on the (<a href= “http) coding and “copy” the information (to learn how to Copy & Paste go to Tutorial #9)
- (3) Sign into your blog account ([www.livejournal.com](http://www.livejournal.com)). Go to “Journal” and “Post Entry.”
- (4) Left click on the tab “HTML” located on the right side of the page
- (5) Right click in the location where you type your blog. Copy and Paste the HTML coding there

\*To see the real image in your blog, left click on “Rich Text”

## Editing Images

In Photobucket, you can change the look of your uploaded image by using effects, distort and animations tabs. Remember, you must “Save” the image for the new effects to be added.

(1) Go to “Edit Images”

- (2) The “Get Photos” page will appear. Left click on the desired photo you wish to change
- (3) A new page will appear. To edit the image, left click on “Options”. (There will be a tab on the top that provides editing choices)
