



Downloading eBooks from the Ontario Library Service Download Centre

For Blackberry Playbook

- 1. Update Playbook Operating System (OS).** You must have the most recent version of the playbook operating system. Tap "Settings" on your Playbook (upper right hand-corner). Select "Software Updates". Tap "Check for Updates", and download the new operating system. It may take a while to download.

Console" in the search bar. Tap the return key on your touch screen keyboard. Tap the first result. Now tap the button underneath the logo that says "download". Wait for the download and installation to complete. Exit out of Blackberry App World.
- 2. Create an adobe ID** account by visiting www.adobe.com/cfusion/membership/index.cfm. The fields marked with the red asterisks are mandatory; if you miss them you will be prompted to fill them in before you can continue. You can leave blank any field without an asterisk. Be sure to remember your login information (your email address and password). You only need to do this once.
- 3. Go to Blackberry App World** and search "Overdrive Media
- 4. Launch Overdrive Media Console** by tapping the Overdrive icon in your list of apps.
5. Read the information screen next for some helpful tips. Then, tap close. Open the menu bar by dragging it down from the top of the screen. Tap "App Settings".
6. Under eBook Options, enter your Adobe ID and your password and tap "Authorize".
7. Now open your menu bar again by dragging it down and tap "Get

Books". Now tap "Add a Library". Enter Owen Sound in the search bar or browse for libraries until you find the "Owen Sound & North Grey Union Public Library". Tap on the star to save the "Ontario Library Service Download Centre" to Overdrive. You should only need to do this once.

8. Tap on the "Ontario Library Service Download Centre" to take you to the mobile website. You will need your library card. Tap Login. Select the **Owen Sound & North Grey Union Public Library** from the list. You will have to scroll all the way down to the O section. Once selected, enter your 14 digit library card barcode (with no spaces) into the new field and your pin, which is the last four digits of your phone number. Now tap "login".

9. Click on "search". TIP: Do an advanced search and select

"show only titles available" on the next screen after you tap "submit". This will help you find books that are not already out. You can also browse the collection and add titles to your cart*. You may download a title if there are available copies or you may place an item in your holds list and be notified when it is available.

*Be careful to choose "Adobe epub" format ebooks.

10. Click on "Proceed to Checkout". Choose your loan period and tap "Confirm Checkout". Tap "Download".
11. Tap on the title of your downloaded ebook to open it. Enjoy!

Note: Tapping the + button to the right of your title will give you the option to return/delete it.
