1. Add shapes, change color, size
2. Use the connector tool
3. Use the ActivInspire tools with other applications on your desktop
4. Hide ActivInspire and use the Desktop to use tools such as Camera and Screen Recorder
5. See all of my flipchart pages, move a page, delete a page
6. Get to the Resource Browser to add images, backgrounds, and other media
7. Access additional tools
8. Open another flipchart, save a flipchart, get "Help" on a question
9. Switch my profile to have quick access to the tools I need
10. Removing borders from around pictures
11. Use the Action Browser to create a motion or action on slides of flipchart
12. Command Actions: Area/Fullscreen Recorder, Calculator, Design Mode, Magic Link, Note Browser, Object Browser, XY Origin
13. Page Actions: Another Page, Clear Page, Copy Page, Cut Page, Delete Page, First/Last Page
14. Object Actions: Extract Text, Grouped, Hidden, Locked, Send to Back
15. Document/Media Actions: Open Document, File or Sound, Open Website
