- ✓ Significant Research and Findings
- ✓ Publications
- ✓ Reputation within the field of psychology

Cut the attached psychologist 'doll' out and attach it to a separate sheet of paper. Place the following information on or around your 'doll':

1. In or around the EYES write their Theoretical Approach to the study of psychology because this determines how they SEE psychology.
2. In or around the HEART write their Name and Nation of origin.
3. In or around their FEET write their significant Research and Findings because this determines what they STAND on in the field of psychology.
4. In or around their HEAD write their significant Publications because this represents what they have spent much of their career THINKING about.
5. In or around their HANDS write about students of theirs who pursued careers in psychology OR subjects from their research who were affected by the research. This represents the individuals who were literally in the palm of the psychologist's hands.
6. In or around their MOUTH write a famous quote by this psychologist; perhaps the words they are most famous for SAYING?
7. In or around their EARS write the criticisms or praise they received for their research. This represents what they HEARD as they progressed through their studies.

Your psychologist 'doll' must include all of the above elements, be clear, neat, colorful, and creative. You must use the doll provided as your 'foundation'- but you can put him/her onto a larger sheet of paper to include more detail/color/information. Use whatever medium you choose: crayons, colored pencils, computer typing, magazine cutouts, paints, fabric, three-dimensional elements, etc.
