

1. exposition - the beginning part of the story which includes the setting, main characters, and background information.

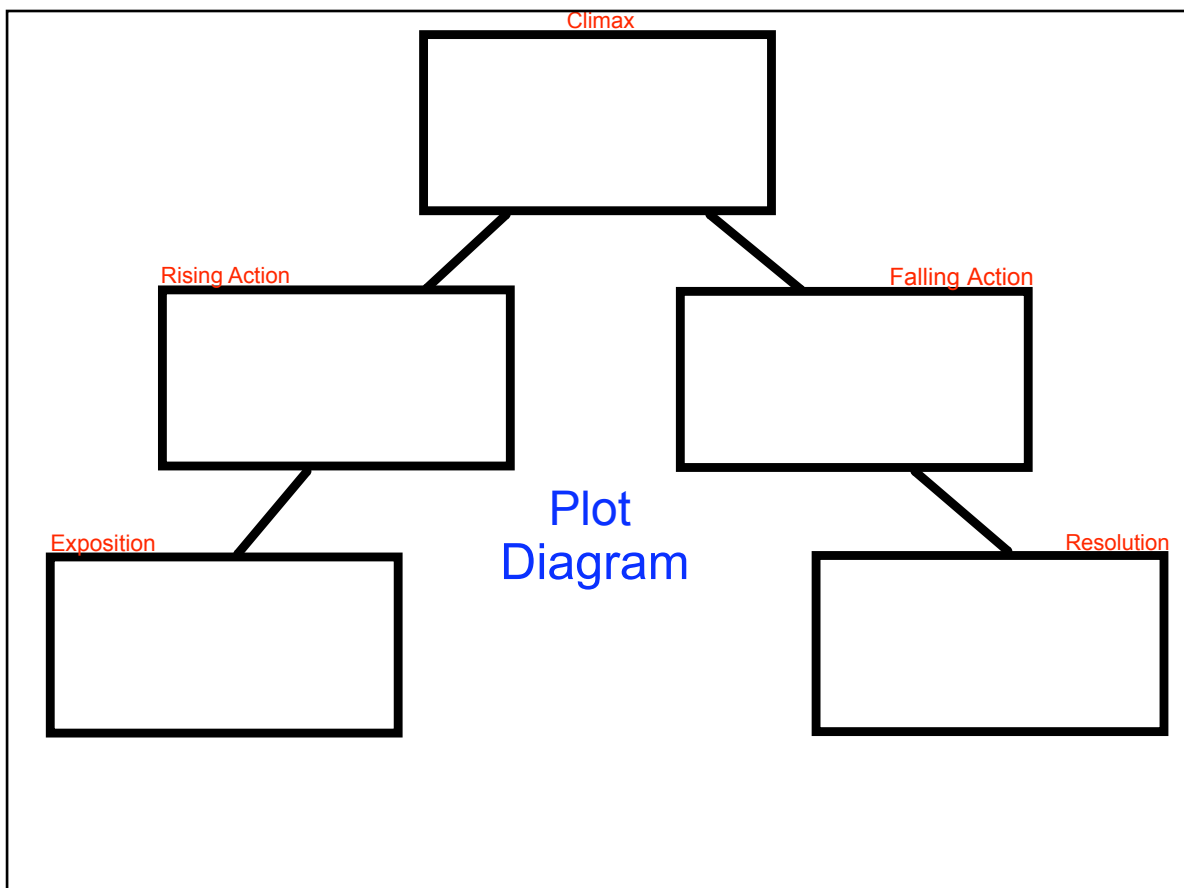

2. rising action - the main problem/conflict of the story is revealed

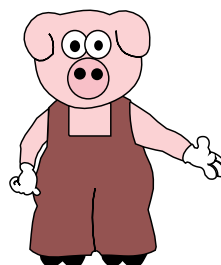
3. climax - the turning point in the story

4. falling action - the main problem/conflict of the story is solved

5. resolution - the story comes to a satisfactory end
