

Using your Airliner Wireless Slate

The SMART Airliner Wireless Slate allows the teacher to move about the room while still interacting with the SMART Board. It also gives students the opportunity to interact with the SMART Board from their seats. The Airliner connects to the computer via Bluetooth technology and works up to 52 feet away. The slate comes with a tethered pen and a wireless mouse making it possible to write, click, and drag items on the board.

Features of the Airliner:

- Wireless interaction up to 52 feet away
- More than one person can use Airliners and the SMART Board at the same time
- Customizable buttons to access your most-used features
- Rest your hand on the slate while you write

- Rechargeable battery

Tips for using an Airliner:

- Look at the board when using the slate
- Rest your hand on the slate when you write
- The space on the slate represents the space of your computer screen or SMART Board

Uses for the Airliner in the Classroom:

- Move about the room while interacting with the board for better classroom management
- Have students stay in their seats, hand them the Airliner to complete a problem
- Have one student at the SMART Board while another uses the slate to complete a problem.
- While a student is at the SMART Board the teacher can interact with the student.
