



Differentiated Spelling

Our spelling tests in second grade are differentiated. This means that every student receives his/her own individualized spelling list each week. All students are given a pre-test of 20 spelling words every Monday. The spelling words that the student spell incorrectly on Monday will become their spelling words for the test on Friday (up to 10 words). If a student gets less than 10 wrong, they then choose spelling words from a Challenge list to make 10 words to study throughout the week. So this way the students are studying words they don't know how to spell, not words that they are familiar with and can spell.
