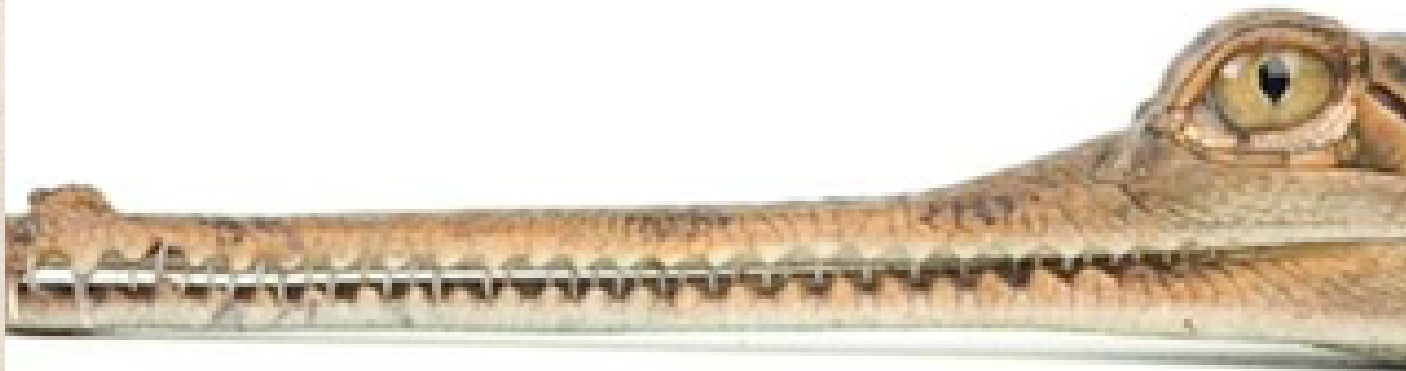
Students search endangered animal sites

improve populations of this animal?**

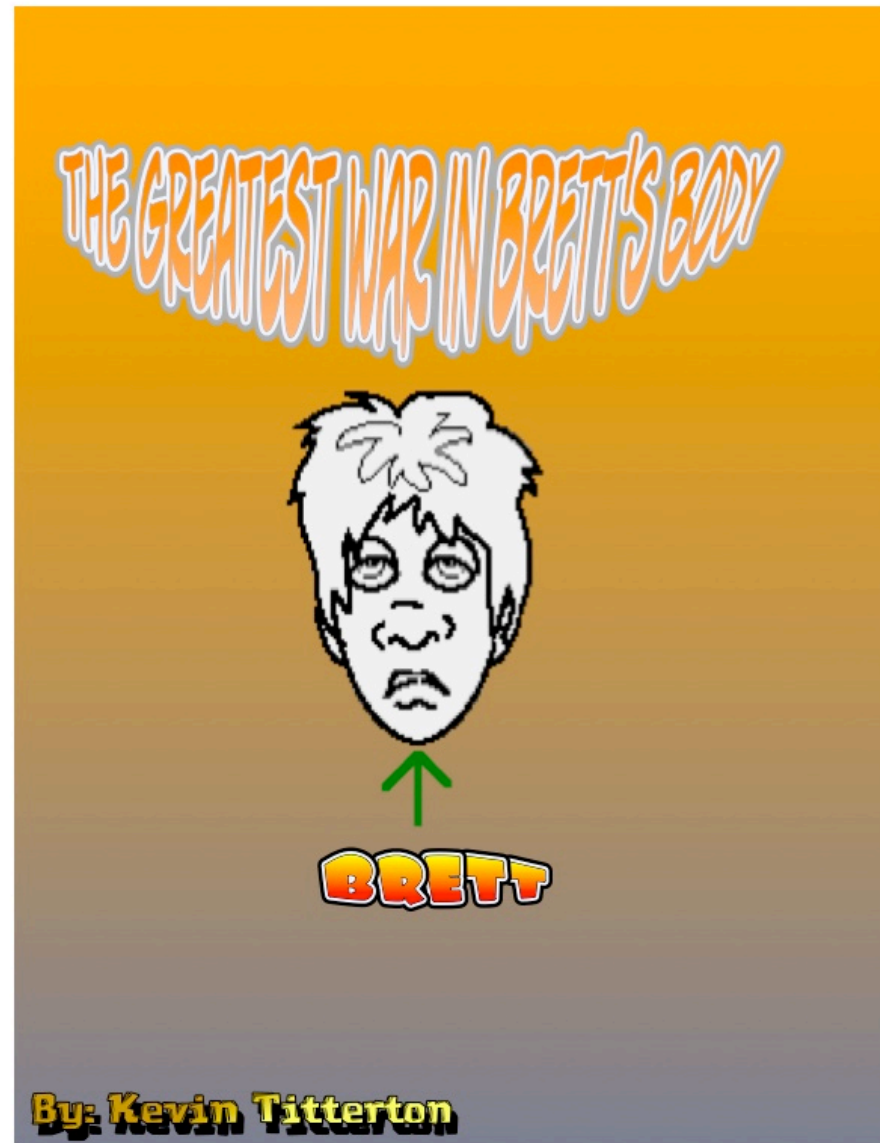

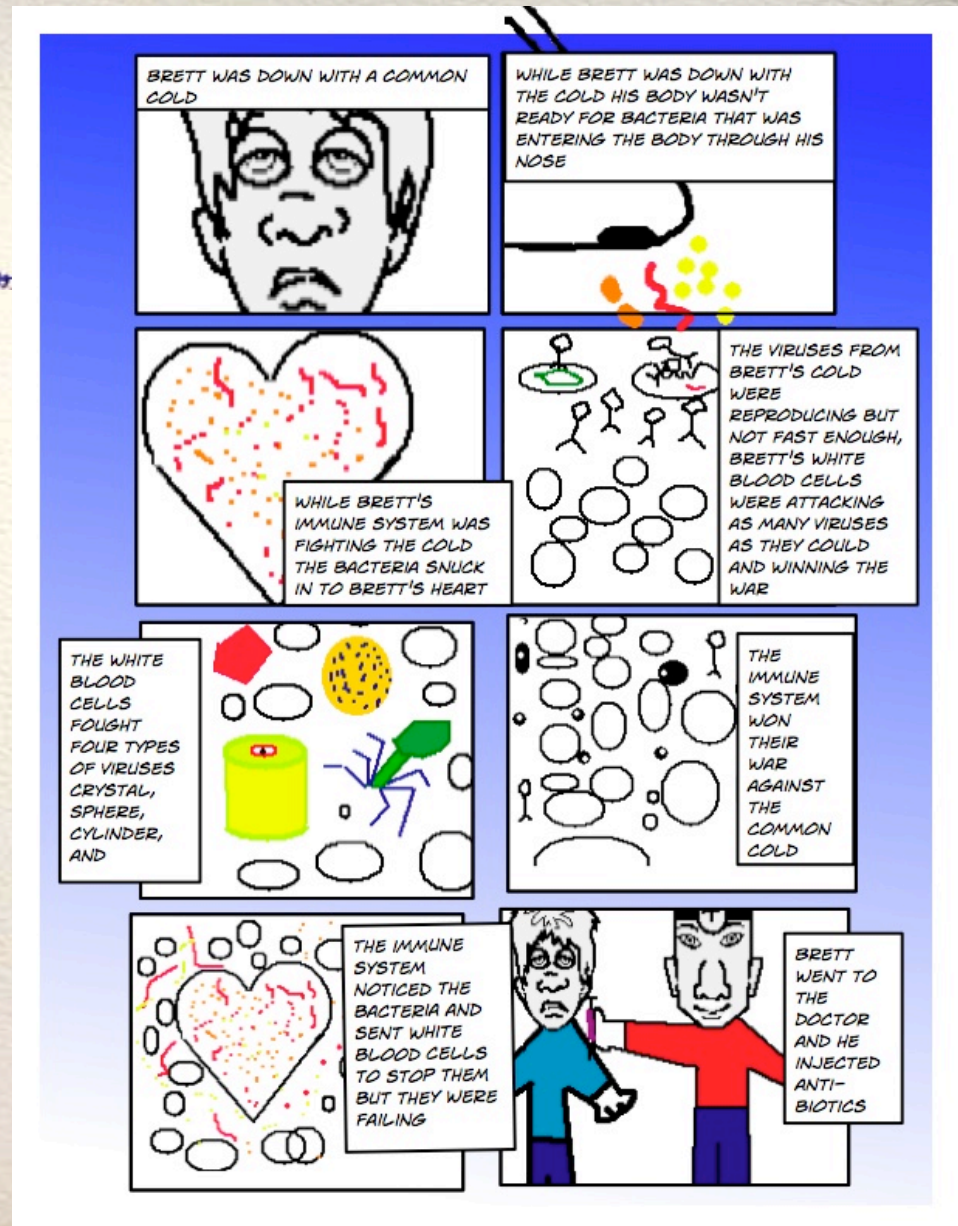

 - I Photo

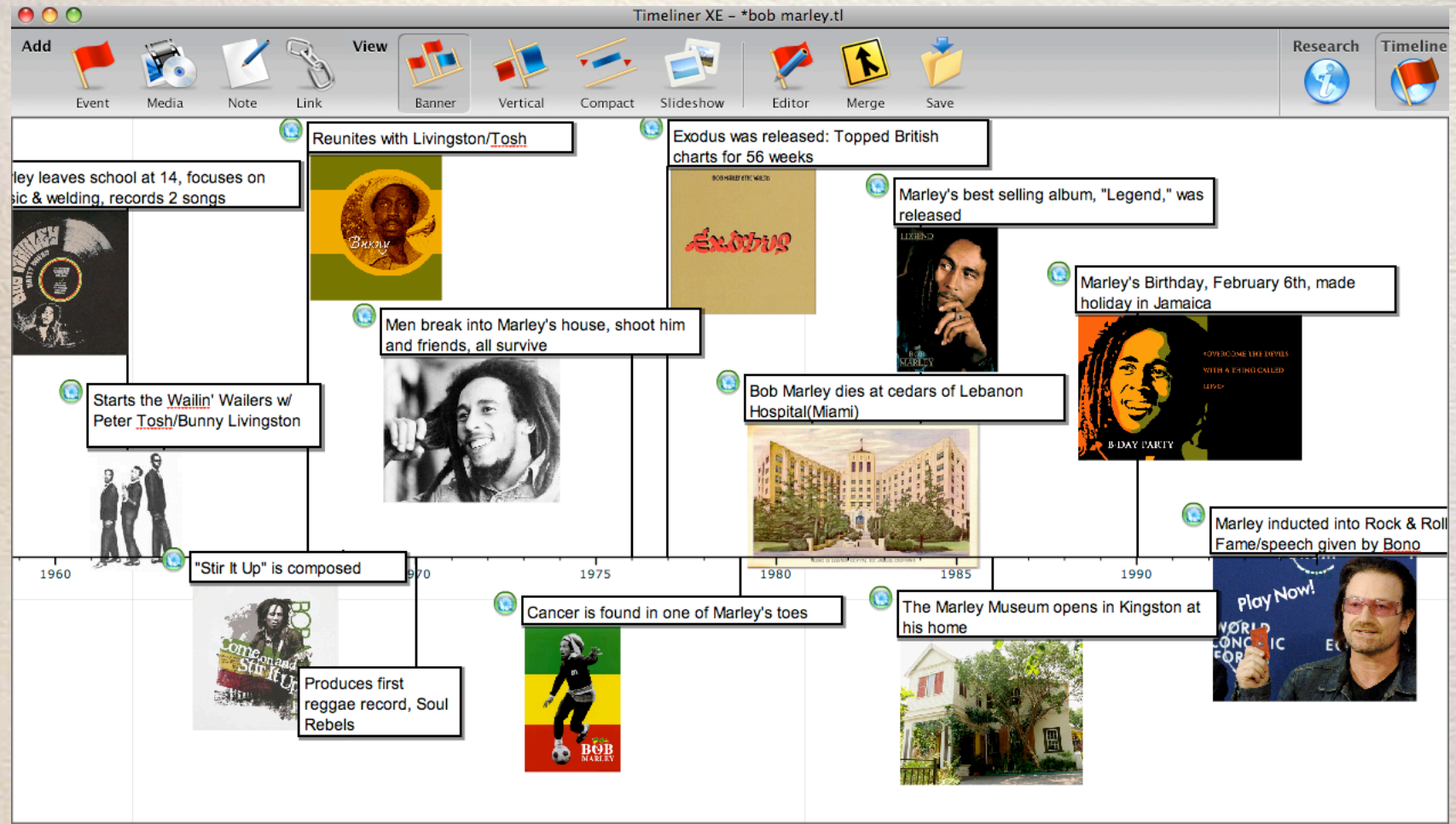
