Materials Required:

Organization and being prepared for class is essential to your success. That is why these things are required and monitored.

- Notebook

3 Ring Binder with dividers: The notebook should be divided into 3 sections as follows:

1. Class Work and Notes
2. Homework
3. Folder

The folder will be used for tests quizzes and review materials.

- Calculator: Texas Instruments TI 83, TI 83+, TI 84, or TI 84+ graphing calculator
- Textbook: The text will be used for daily homework. You may leave it at home.
- Writing Implement: Always have a pencil with you when you come to math class.
Pen is acceptable, but pencil and eraser is encouraged to keep things neat.

Homework Policy:

- Homework is the heart of any mathematics course and will be assigned daily.
- All homework assignments will be posted on the board, and copied by the student.
- All work must be shown on homework problems. If you cannot complete a problem you must **copy the entire problem** and leave space to write the solution in class.
- Homework turned in late will not be accepted except in the case of illness.
- For each missing homework assignment, 5 points will be deducted from your grade.

The Grading Policy:

- Your grade will be determined by the average of your test grades.
- A Quarterly exam counts as a test grade.
- The Quarter exam grade, if higher, will replace the lowest test grade.
- Homework will be checked daily and counted as a test grade for the quarter (this cannot be replaced by the quarterly exam).
