- Exams will be open notebook. You may only use **YOUR** notes. You may not use the notes of another student. You may not use any type of photocopied or printed out notes. If you are absent, it will be your responsibility to get the notes that you miss.
- There will be no review sheets before the exams. There will still be review in class the day before each test.
- You are expected to be focused and on task on a daily basis. Disruption or disrespect will not be tolerated.
