Notes about the clinic schedules-

1. The day to day schedules are all in amion.com

3. If the location has a number in parenthesis in front of the location (e.g. see "chronic renal" above), that means that the clinic only meets on that day of each month (e.g. chronic renal- (3)PHC means that that clinic meets on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Wed AM of the calendar month). The actual

dates you should attend the clinic will be reflected in amion.com.

4. The phone number listed is for the nurse's station. If you will not be in attendance or to check if the clinic is still happening, you can call that number at the start of the clinic. You can also check with the clinic attending (in parenthesis next to clinic name) at beginning of the rotation.
5. Please use the learning objectives to encourage and guide clinical teaching.
6. Reading time is elective time for you to read or work on your projects.
7. Family Medicine Clinics (FMCs) will replace 2-3 of the above assigned specialty clinics and will be reflected in amion.com.
